We are Sims Metal. We are committed to operating responsibly, which is one of our three sustainability pillars. Each year, we receive thousands of tons of steel and other metals, process them, and then we send those materials directly to mills, foundries and smelters for remelting so they can create new products.

We have a considerable footprint in Rhode Island. For more than 10 years, our three facilities across the state have received end-of-life vehicles, appliances, and industrial metals from community businesses and neighbors just like you.



Sims Metal has three facilities in Rhode Island.

- A seven-acre facility on Allens Avenue in Providence with deep water port access that caters to other recycling companies throughout the state and the New England region.

Benefit: Sims Metal can export ferrous metals to ports throughout the world via a network of vessels. Reduces the amount of material sent to landfill. Preserves steel and other metal for future use for as long as possible.

- A two-acre facility on Allens Avenue in Providence catering to the general public and local companies.

Benefit: Able to drop off ferrous and non-ferrous recyclable materials.

- A 14-acre facility on Green Earth Ave in Johnston that caters to the general public and companies.

Benefit: Able to drop off ferrous and non-ferrous recyclable materials.



Sims Metal pays more than \$1.2 million annually in property taxes.



Sims Metal employs approximately 60 local residents with average annual salaries up to \$90K across its three facilities.



Approximately 70 loads of recyclables are transported throughout the state daily, supporting the local economy.



Sims Metal's operations are heavily regulated by the RIDEM, EPA, CRMC, and the Coast Guard.



Sims Metal invested \$80K to support decarbonization in the state by planting trees, shrubs and plants along Allens Avenue.
